- Liaise with staff, guardians/families and external agencies to facilitate supports, conduct assessments and/or coordinate intervention & services
- Participate in the development of individual education plans alongside the student, school support and community care teams
- Part-time, flexible scheduling

- Masters in Counselling Psychology, Masters in Marriage and Family Therapy, Masters in Education - Counselling or Masters in Social Work with a Clinical focus
- Clinical training & experience supporting trauma recovery
- Experience counselling children & youth in crisis as well as family members, ideally including indigenous clients
- Ability to apply & apply counseling practices outside of a traditional practice model
- Registered member (or eligible for registration) with B.C. Association of Clinical Counsellors or a Certified member of the Canadian Counselling and Psychotherapy Association
- An understanding of the history of indigenous peoples & communities, and the current implications including generation trauma
- Comfort in a school setting with the ability to care for self and others in dynamic situations
- Knowledge of incorporating indigenous, particularly Coast Salish, ways of knowing & learning in professional practice and personal learning journey
- Above all, a passion for supporting vulnerable children & youth and their families
